We have finished Topic 4 Lesson 1: Plants Use Energy.

We will be taking a quiz next FRIDAY 9/21 on photosynthesis. Quizzes are normally on Wednesdays but due to the field trip to the Tampa Bay History Center on 9/19 it is moved to Friday.

Students will be getting a study guide on Tuesday night to help them study. I have posted the study guide on the website as well. If you choose to study over the weekend, you can print it out from there.

All students will get a hard copy of the study guide Tuesday 9/18 for homework.

****Reminder: Science homework given on Tuesdays and is due on Wednesday. Students receive a participation grade for their homework.**

****If they do not do it or forget, they should still turn it in late and receive up to a 75% as a grade.**

****Homework is posted on my website if it is ever lost or forgotten at school.**

We've spent the week asking and answering questions about what we are reading, digging deeper into "how" predictions when reading and continuing to work on describing characters. We will have a quiz on describing characters on Tuesday September 18! Students have practiced identifying the feelings, traits and motivations behind characters.

We've also been working on responding to our reading using text evidence to support our answer. Students are continuing to work on this all year long.

Despite my previous update, students are not quite ready to fill out reading logs on their own yet. We will continue to fill them out at school until I feel they are ready to do this independently at home.

I will do my very best to get the vocabulary packets scanned and uploaded to the team page ASAP.
